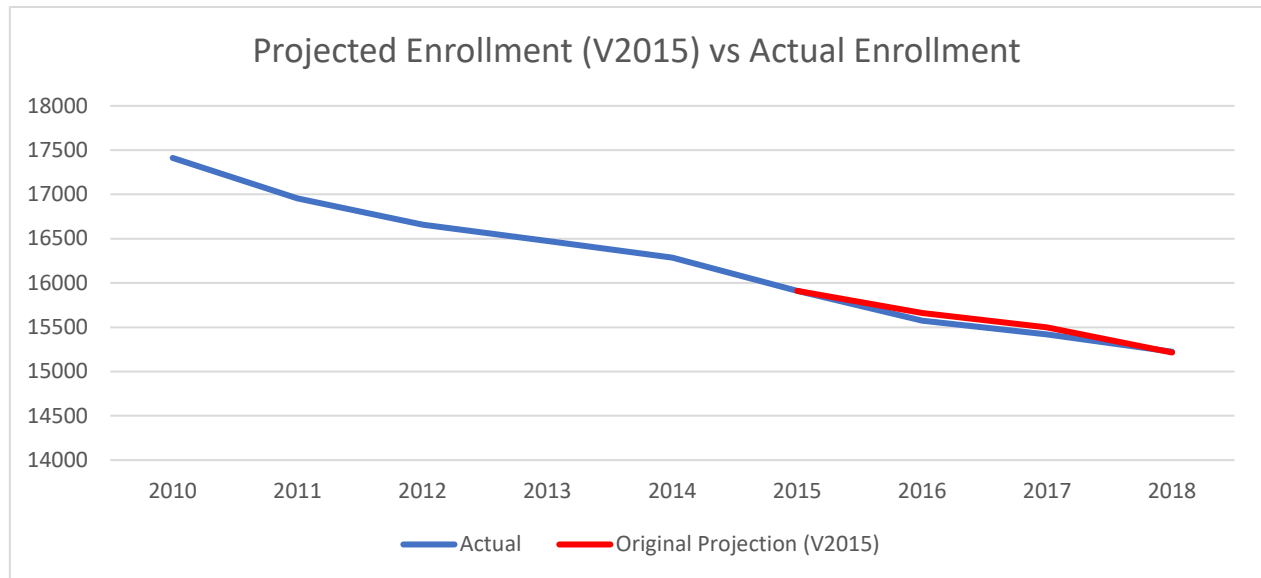

County Projections

In 2015, the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission released the “Berkshire Public School Enrollment Trends” report which reviewed current enrollment trends in the county as well as projecting future enrollment out to 2025 based on births and year-to-year grade changes. In the 3 years since the report, the trends at the county level have mostly remained the same, with the 2015 projections for 2018 being within 9 students of actual. In 2018 there was a total of 15,224 students enrolled in public schools for kindergarten through grade 12.

Figure 1. Actual Enrollment vs Projected



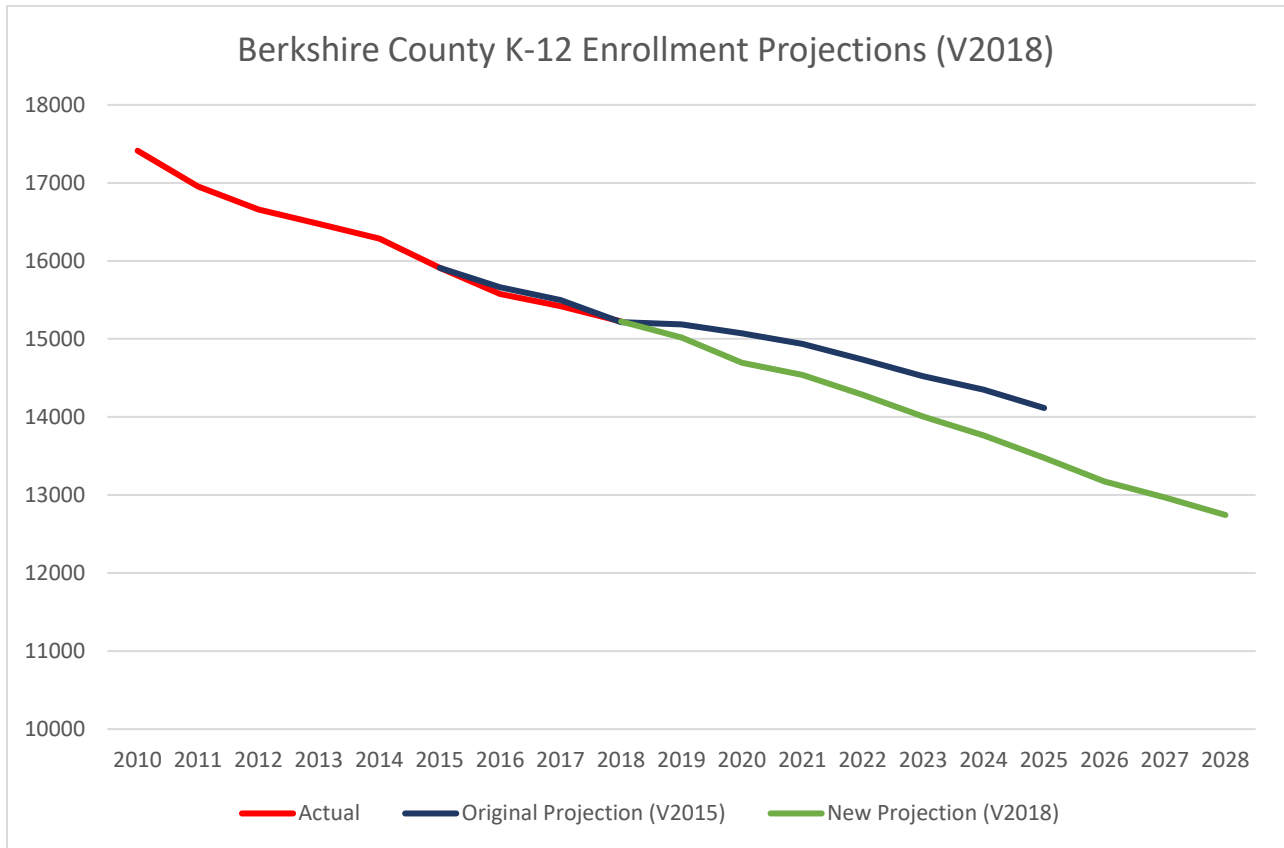
The new V2018 projections, which run from 2018 – 2028, incorporate two more years of births and three more years of enrollment trends. The enrollment data shows that there are slightly fewer students moving out/choosing out of the county than originally projected. The birth data shows an even greater decline than the V2015 projections (35 less/year than V2015). Student movement between grades impacts the short-term projections, however births have a larger impact on long term projections. With steeper declines to births, the new projections show a larger decline in enrollment. Overall, by 2028, Berkshire County is projected to have a K-12 Public School Enrollment of 12,744, which is 2,480 less than the 2018 enrollment, a decline of 16% (See Table 1 and Figure 2).

School District Projections

In reviewing the 2018 actual enrollment to the V2015 projections, while the county numbers are very close, the individual school districts varied from the V2015 projections, mostly due to changes in migration into and out of the district (Table 2).

The new projections (V2018) are shown in Table 3 and take into account any changes in births and in/out migration and choosing neighboring districts. It is important to note that given the very small size of many districts, these school district level projections have a large margin of error. A change of one or two students can have a large impact on the projections.

In the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District, there were 32 less students enrolled than projected. There are significantly fewer students currently enrolled in elementary school than projected. This may be due to the closure of the Cheshire Elementary School and parents sending their children to other districts. The district also has significantly fewer in 9th grade than projected, which could be due to students transferring to the vocational school. The district has seen more births than originally projected, so that will have a positive influence on the projections. The district is projected to lose 238 (20%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Berkshire Arts & Technology Charter School had significantly less than projected, however this is largely due to the school having a cap on enrollment that we were unaware about when creating the 2015 projections.

The Berkshire Hills Regional School District had 71 fewer students enrolled than projected. It appears that the district has had a larger number of students moving out or choosing out than projected. This movement tends to be more in the elementary and middle schools. Births in the district are on target from what was originally projected, but the increased movement out will lead to a lower projection. The district is projected to lose 180 (15%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Central Berkshire Regional School District had 25 more students than projected. It appears they have fewer students moving out or choosing out than projected. Births within the district are slightly lower, but with the increase in the number of students staying in district, the projections show a higher enrollment than previous projections, but still below today. The district is projected to lose 199 (13%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Clarksburg School District had 45 more students than projected. This is largely due to having a much larger Kindergarten class in 2018 than projected, but also seeing an increase in the number of students staying within the district rather than moving/choosing out of district. The numbers of births is the same as the previous projections, but with the higher movement in, the projections show a decline,

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but not as much as previously projected. The district is projected to lose 29 (15%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Farmington River Regional School District was on target, being off by only one student in the original projections. The projections for 2028 are in line with the original projections. The district is projected to lose 12 (13%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Florida School District had seven less than projected, mostly because they have had slightly more students moving out/choosing out than projected. The district is seeing slightly more births than projected, which results in projected enrollment being higher than the original projections. The district is projected to lose 21 (31%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Hancock School District had five more students than projected. This is largely due to them gaining one student a year versus losing 1 student per year on average. The district is seeing slightly more births than projected, which results in projected enrollment being higher than the original projections. The district is projected to lose 9 (29%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Lee School District had 33 more students than projected. The district is seeing fewer students moving out than projected and saw a significant increase in students in 9th grade. This is countered by 5 fewer births on average than projected. These lower birth totals will result in fewer students in 2028. The district is projected to lose 81 (12%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Lenox School District saw 76 more students enrolled than projected. The district is seeing more students moving in/choosing in than projected throughout the grades, except for the later years of high school. The district is seeing fewer births than projected, but with their increase in students moving in/choosing in, their enrollment, while still going down, will be higher than originally projected. The district is projected to lose 141 (119%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Northern Berkshire Vocational School District saw 4 less than projected, but has a stable enrollment now and projected into the future.

The Mount Greylock Regional School District (formerly the Lanesborough, Williamstown and Mount Greylock School Districts) saw 10 fewer students than projected. They saw more losses in high school and more gains in elementary than projected. The district has seen a lower number of births than projected, but given past births and migration, they will have slightly more students than projected, but still below today's enrollment. The district is projected to lose 135 (12%) students between 2018 and 2028

The North Adams School District saw 42 more students than projected. They are seeing fewer students moving out/choosing out than projected. North Adams had 5 fewer births per year on average than projected, however with fewer students moving out/choosing out, their future enrollment, while still declining, will be more than originally projected. The district is projected to lose 261 (20%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Pittsfield School District saw 61 fewer students than projected. The district is seeing more students moving out/choosing out than projected, except for high school. This is especially true in Kindergarten which is seeing 48 more students moving out than projected. The 2018 Kindergarten enrollment is larger than previous classes, however this is due to a larger number of births in 2012 than the previous

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or later years. Overall, Pittsfield's births are 16 less than projected and with the higher numbers moving out/choosing out, the enrollment projected for 2028 will be lower than originally projected. The district is projected to lose 1,037 (19%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Richmond School District saw 5 more students than projected and is seeing slightly more students moving in/choosing in throughout the grades. Richmond has the same number of births as originally projected, but with more students moving in/choosing in, they will see slightly more students than originally projected. The district is projected to gain 24 (15%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Savoy School District saw 19 more than projected. The district is seeing far more students moving in/choosing in for Kindergarten through 2nd grade than projected. The district is seeing fewer births than projected, but with the increase in students moving in/choosing in, they will see more students enrolled than originally projected, however it is still lower than today's enrollment. The district is projected to lose 20 (41%) students between 2018 and 2028

The Southern Berkshire Regional School District had 19 more students enrolled than projected. They are seeing more students moving in/choosing in than projected, especially in elementary and high school. The births are slightly lower than projected, but with the increase in students moving in, they will see a higher enrollment than originally projected, but still below today's enrollment. The district is projected to lose 162 (25%) students between 2018 and 2028
