To Note:

In 2017, there were a number of economic indicators where the Berkshire's performed well and a number where the region did not perform as well as compared to the state and nation.

The region saw improvements in educational attainment and also saw decreases in children in poverty. The region decreased in 3rd grade literacy, which may be due to the new MCAS tests, and graduation rate.

The region saw increases in labor force participation and declines in unemployment, but also saw declines in total employment and increases in commuting time.

The region saw increases in incomes for the first time in several years and a decrease in poverty for the first time in years. There was also an improvement in income inequality.
